Targa Bambina

HANS Devises

The HANS devises, that Gavin Riches donated, have been delayed in shipping and it is unlikely that they will arrive before the Bambina event. As discussed with those people who have expressed interest in the use of them there will be some conditions that you will need to agree to, we will get the terms and conditions finalised and put it up on the website after Targa Bambina, so we will let you know once it has been completed.

We HIGHLY RECOMEND the use of HANS or some form of neck restraint and while it is not compulsory at this stage it is something we would like to introduce in the future so when you need to replace your helmets please consider this and ensure your helmets are compatible.

Recovery Vehicles

We have engaged FIRST Recovery to supply two Hook Trucks specifically for this event. They will collect any vehicle stopped in stage and remove them to the pre arranged drop off points at the end of each stage. These locations are in the Service Books, so your service crews will know where to collect you from if you need to be recovered. This service is different to what has been provided in the past and we are trialling them for future events, so please give us your feed back after the event.
