

Terms and Conditions for the Invitation Process

The Invitation to Compete is a two-stage process. The number of entries will be restricted.

All Targa New Zealand events are run under Motorsport New Zealand Inc jurisdiction.

The Organisers reserve the right to decline any application without disclosing the reason.

1: Application Form:

Once you have received the Application to Compete forms please return them together with a photo of your car and a non-refundable deposit of \$600.00, including GST. If your application is unsuccessful, you may be asked to submit another vehicle for consideration. Vehicle details and modifications must be filled out. If details are found to differ from that given your invitation may be rescinded and fees forfeited or excluded from all results.

2: Invitation to Compete:

Once your application is received and accepted by the Vehicle Selection Committee, the successful applicant will be advised and receipt of an invoice confirms your application.

An entrant wishing to change the vehicle originally nominated must notify the organisers who reserve the right to withdraw the original invitation and consider the proposed replacement vehicle as a new application. Additional crew members may be nominated as replacements.

3: Entry Fees: (refer attached schedule)

All Entry fees include all the benefits set out in the relevant section 4.

Entry is conditional on the following:

- (a) The nominated vehicle being acceptable to the Vehicle Selection Committee.
- (b) All payments kept current and paid in full by the last day of the Entry pricing structure you have chosen. Late entries must be paid 30 days prior to event start.

4: Entry Fees include:

- (a) Lunches for Driver & Co driver for each day of competition, two tickets to the Prizegiving Function, competition numbers, road books, route maps, two Targa patches, and registration of one service vehicle.
- (b) **Not included in any entry fees are:**
 - (1) Accommodation costs
 - (2) Insurance costs
 - (3) Extra Event Function costs
 - (4) Fuel costs
 - (5) Registration of additional service vehicles

All those items in section B are additional costs.

5: Payment:

- (a) A **non-refundable deposit** must accompany the completed Application Form before your application will be considered.
- (b) All payments of subsequent instalments must be paid by the due date. Late payment of any instalment will automatically discontinue any discounts received. i.e.: An Early Bird entry will convert to a Standard Entry.
- (c) If entering all 3 events, payments can be paid in 6 instalments, either by bank automatic payment or credit card. Please advise administration if you wish to use this option

6: Refunds:

All withdrawals must be in writing

The following is the criteria for refunds:

- (a) If an application has not been accepted the deposit sent with the application will be refunded.
- (b) An applicant who is issued with an invitation to compete or withdraws the application before being issued with an invitation will forfeit the deposit.
- (c) An applicant who is issued with an invitation to compete at any time and who withdraws from the competition prior to three months before that event start date will forfeit the deposit.
- (d) Any applicant withdrawing from the competition within three months of the start date of that event will forfeit the deposit plus two further payments of \$600.00.
- (e) Any applicant may withdraw and, at the discretion of the organisers, up to 75% of all payments made may be transferred to another Club Targa organised event within the next 12 month period, providing payment schedules are up to date and the vehicle nominated is acceptable to the Vehicle Selection Committee.
- (f) The Invitation to Compete is not transferable to another applicant or any other person.

7: Where applications have been transferred to another Targa run event:

- (a) Transferred applicants will not be automatically issued with a new Invitation to Complete in that Targa run event.
- (b) Transferred applicants are required to lodge a new application with the Organisers on the official Application Form.
- (c) If a transferred applicant does not subsequently compete in that Targa run event OR subsequently withdraws from that event then the remaining credit balance transferred is forfeited.

8: Licences:

- (a) **For New Zealand Competitors:** Driver and Co-Driver require current full civil driving licences and MSNZ National Rally Licences. First-time Targa competitors must attend a MSNZ-recognised driving school OR have previously competed in a rally OR ralliesprint event.
- (b) **For International Competitors other than Australians:** Driver and Co-driver require current full civil driving licences and equivalent MSNZ National Rally Licences issued by their parent ASN accompanied by the declarations as detailed in NSC Schedule L Article 5.3 (amendment 34003).
- (c) **For Australian Competitors:** Driver and Co-driver require current full civil driving licences and CAMS Rally Motorsport Licences with a CAMZ Tasman Visa.

9: How to obtain a National Rally Licence:

Licence forms, (MSNZ A001) can be found on the MSNZ website: www.motorsport.org.nz, click on "Forms", scroll down to Admin and download form A001. Then Go to "Examiners Questions" for copies of oral & written questions & Examiners Contact details. You must belong to a car club to complete this form. 10: What is the Format?

TARGA BAMBINA: 2-day event based around Auckland in March.

TARGA ROTORUA: 2-day event based around Rotorua in June.

DUNLOP TARGA: 6 day event starting in Auckland and finishing in Wellington in October.

At each of the overnight stops all competitors cars are displayed to the local community. Each day there are approximately 8 Targa closed stages varying in length and degree of difficulty all on tarmac roads.

11: Safety Equipment Required for TARGA:

- (a) All competing vehicles must have a current registration and warrant of fitness.
- (b) All vehicles shall have steel roll-over protection that meets their ASN rules.
- (c) All vehicles must carry or have fitted safety triangle, first aid kit, fire extinguisher and approved safety 4-point harness, as per their ASN rules.
- (d) All drivers and co-drivers must have MSNZ/ASN /FIA approved protective helmets and clothing.

12: Supplementary Regulations:

Supplementary Regulations specific to the event you have entered will be posted out approximately 6 weeks prior to the event

13: Tyres: (not applicable to The Tour)

- (a) A maximum number of tyres per car are allowed before incurring time penalties. These are to be of commercially available Dunlop touring road tyres.
- (b) Dunlop Tyres are the mandatory brand although in some circumstances an exemption maybe considered. Exemption must be applied for in writing to the Organising Committee.

There is a Dunlop Targa preferential pricing on tyres once your entry has been accepted. - (c) For Targa Bambina and Targa Rotorua a maximum of five (5) tyres per car of commercially available Dunlop touring road tyres.
- (d) For Dunlop Targa a maximum of eight (8) tyres per car of commercially available Dunlop touring road tyres.

14: Eligible Cars and Categories

Classic Competition

Category 0: Vehicles older than 40 years
Category 1: Vehicles 30 to 40 years old
Category 2: Vehicles 25 to 30 years old
Category 3: Vehicles 20 to 25 years old
Category 4: (Super GT Classic) Vehicles older than 20 years with modifications beyond that allowed for each category

Modern Competition

Category 5: Vehicles 15 to 20 years old
Category 6: Vehicles 10 to 15 years old
Category 7: Vehicles 5 to 10 years old
Category 8: Vehicles new to 5 years old
Category 9: (Super GT Modern) Vehicles up to 20 years old with modifications beyond that allowed for each category

Limited numbered production vehicles and performance GT production vehicles will automatically go into the Super GT category depending on age, all other vehicles will be allowed only the following modifications to remain within their appropriate age category.

All Vehicles:

Brakes are free.
Suspension is free, providing the original pick up points are used.
Production size intake and exhaust manifolds.
Gearbox ratios and differential ratios are free.
Engine management units are free.

2WD Vehicles:

As per all vehicles plus the following;
2WD drive vehicles may increase the production wheel diameter by a max of 2"

Forced Induction vehicles must run a restrictor, (maximum 36mm).

4WD Vehicles:

As per all vehicles plus the following;
4WD vehicles must retain production wheel diameter..

Forced Induction:

Must run the appropriate restrictor ie 32 or 36 mm as per MSNZ regulations.
Production wheel diameter.
Any vehicles not running a restrictor will automatically go into the super GT category.

TVD GPS Tracing Units:

All vehicles in Categories 4 and 9 must have a TVD GSP Tracking unit fitted to monitor speed

All cars are accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee with a high standard of car presentation being the main criteria.

Preference will be given to Sports, GT, V8 cars and cars with competition history.

The Targa Tour

15: Targa Tour Licences:

The Driver and Co-Driver must both have a full civil drivers licence and a MSNZ Club Sport Licence.

16: To obtain a Club Sport Licence for The Targa Tour:

apply using the MSNZ Licence application form A001, website www.motorsport.org.nz click on "Forms".

17: Safety Equipment required for The Targa Tour:

- (a) All competing vehicles must have a current registration and warrant of fitness.
- (b) All vehicles must carry a safety triangle, first aid kit, fire extinguisher and tow rope
